Clone (command)

The ``clone`` command allows you to clone a configuration from a system image to another one, or from the running config to another system image. The syntax is the reverse of the [copy](#) command.

To clone the running config to a system image:

```
vyos@vyos-rtr:~$ clone system config <system-image> from running
```

To clone from system image A to system image B:

```
vyos@vyos-rtr:~$ clone system config <system-image-B> from <system-image-A>
```
