



Up (command)

The ``up`` command allows you to navigate one level higher in the configuration tree. To get to the top, you can either use the ``up`` command repeatedly or simply use the ``top`` command. To navigate down in the tree, use the ``edit`` command.

Syntax

```
[edit interfaces ethernet eth0]
vyos@vyos-rtr# up
[edit interfaces]
vyos@vyos-rtr#
```

Examples

```
[edit interfaces ethernet eth0 vif 222 ip]
vyos@vyos-rtr# up
[edit interfaces ethernet eth0 vif 222]
vyos@vyos-rtr# up
[edit interfaces ethernet eth0]
vyos@vyos-rtr# up
[edit interfaces]
vyos@vyos-rtr# up
[edit]
vyos@vyos-rtr#
```
